- Shipped AI developer tooling used across the company: an iframe app generator and AI skill that scaffolds platform-styled, logic-plumbed apps from a two-sentence prompt.
- Built an AI Skill/MCP over an internal data explorer covering five API providers; engineers retrieve account or order session data with a short prompt and a small JavaScript snippet.
- Embedded AI auto-review into a fail-fast GitLab CI/CD suite with unit, end-to-end, and visual-diff tests, shortening pull-request cycles and adding coverage reporting.
- Stood up unit-test practice where it had not been required: 7,000+ test files and 61% coverage in three months; doubled team velocity, cut regressions 40%, and drove production reverts from ~8/month to 0 for two months.
- Partnered with the CPTO on an authenticated iframe engine with bidirectional data sharing; delivered five production implementations in one quarter without blocking the core platform.
